# 2022 Western Cape Rider Rankings explained

The Western Cape Rider Rankings is an initiative started in this very province with the aim to encourage our riders to actively compete and to continuously seek to improve themselves and work towards moving up through the grades.

- > It is open to all graded horses and riders registered with Dressage SA in the Western Cape.
- Consistent performance is rewarded; results are published quarterly to generate a sense of competition.
- > Once a year we gather to celebrate the winners in each category at the Annual WCD Awards Function.

## So what is the process?

- The Western Cape Rider Rankings are calculated **over the calendar year** from 1st **January to 31st December.**
- The Show Holding Bodies have the responsibility of sending all results to us for the rankings timeously and in a clear and legible format with clearly marked date, age group, grade, test, judges, correct rider name as per DSA registration and correct horse name with results (including each judge if more than one) in percentage format.
- These are then captured into the Rider Ranking Database in order that the calculations can be effected.
  - A minimum of 2 show venues must be attended to be eligible for a ranking

### How are the Rankings calculated?

The **grade in which you are registered** determines the basis of the calculation which is applied. The rules are as follows (and apply to Children, Pony Riders, Juniors and Adults alike unless otherwise specified):

#### 1. All grades up to and including Small Tour

The ranking percentage is calculated on the average of the **top 6 scores** for each rider/horse combination. If a rider has only done 4 tests in the year the scores are still divided by 6. This rewards the riders who have consistently entered shows and encourages riders to compete in at least 6 tests in a year. The more you ride the better selection of top tests you have!

You need to have done a minimum of 4 tests to be considered for any rider ranking award

#### 2. From Adult Medium Tour to Big Tour

The **top 3 scores** for each rider/horse combination is counted for the rankings. This is because fewer tests are available

You need to have done a minimum of 2 tests in each section ie either Medium tour or Big Tour to be considered for any rider ranking award in that section.

#### 3. Pony Rider Prelim

The rider must have a minimum of 3 scores counted from tests 3 and 4 (i.e. with canter)

#### 4. 10 and Under Riders

We request that any 10 and under riders notify us if they are competing in Pony Rider classes that are

not specifically for 10 and under as we like to acknowledge them but do not have a ranking for 10 and under specifically

## What if I upgrade my horse/pony during the year?

#### Riding up or down a grade:

- A horse and rider combination cannot win more than one Grade in a calendar year.
- Should this happen the second ranked rider in the lower grade will win the award for that lower grade.
- Please note if you ride a test in a higher grade than the grade you are registered, the points will
  count towards the grade of the test you ride (For example, you are EM and ride a Medium test the
  percentage obtained in that test will count for rider rankings in Medium grade.) If you ride in a grade
  lower than the grade you are registered in, it does not count at all.

## Which shows count towards the ranking?

Results from all **graded shows** run under the auspices of **Dressage Western Cape will be included** in the calculations for the Rider Rankings. Note that this includes Prelim classes at graded shows even though they are not graded per se.

A <u>minimum of 2 show venues</u> must be attended to be eligible for a ranking (this excludes Eden riders who only have GRC venue to attend)

#### It is worth noting that the following are excluded:

- SANESA results
  - Even though the classes are graded, they are not included in the calculations as SANESA shows are not run under Dressage Western Cape
- Results from Recreational/Practice dressage shows
- Results from Recreational/Practice classes which are held at graded dressage shows
- Registered DSA ungraded rider/ horse combinations –noted with an "R" on the ranking list. Your
  marks do not count towards WC rankings unless you decide to upgrade to a graded DSA rider
  during that ranking year, your scores will then automatically be changed to a ranked rider eligible
  for the awards.

#### What if I don't agree with the results?

Whilst every effort is made to include all results correctly, there are sometimes occasions where our percentages do not tally with what you have calculated. Often these instances are as a result of show results not being sent in so we urge you to keep track of your rides.

**If you do have a query, please contact Luzaan Slabbert** wcdressagerankings@gmail.com and remember to include the details of all shows and tests ridden so that we can see where tests have been missed or incorrectly captured. We will then address your query to the Show Holding Bodies.

The more information with which you can provide us, the easier it will be for us to assist you - we recommend that you send a list of show venues, dates, current grade, tests ridden, results and the relevant judge and we may need to ask you for your proof if we not have records from show-holders.

#### What about my Out-of-Province results?

Dressage Show results are only sent to us from registered WC Dressage Show Holding Bodies. This means that we will not automatically be aware of your rides at shows out of Province.

Should you want these included in the rankings (again, **only DSA graded** registered shows and not SANESA), please send the proof of the results of all tests ridden within 2 months of the show and before 31<sup>st</sup> December of the rankings year. Please include the details of the show (venue and date) and tests ridden. Any tests not sent with all required details within this timeframe cannot be included.

Why is my ranking percentage different on DSA? The DSA Rankings are not maintained in the Western Cape and so can differ for a number of different reasons. If you have a query around those numbers, kindly contact DSA directly on admin@dressagesa.com.
