The North West Dressage Championships is a provincial competition of which similar is hosted by other provinces within their region, to afford competitors the opportunity to compete for the provincial title. Dressage is an Olympic Equestrian sport which involves a rider only high captures and their horse, to embark on a journey of training through the various levels, from preliminary to Grand Prix to execute movements as prescribed Grand Prix to execute movements as prescribed by a dressage test. These movements vary from transitions between the gates of walk, trot and canter and also within the gate itself, as collected, working or extended. The aim is to execute these movements with accuracy and precision in harmony with their horse. Dressage is there for a means to develop the horse's confidence, suppleness and strength as a gymnast, forming a partnership with
