	In the event that the show is cancelled, 80% of the entry fees will be refunded.	
	80% of the total entry value will be refunded <u>if</u> scratched <u>before</u> the show entries closing date.	
	No refund will be given to any rider and horse that are scratched <u>after</u> the closing date of show entries. Entries will not be carried over to the following qualifier.

	Show entries have been capped at 80 entries on a first come first serve basis.

The Series Rules:  Entrants (the same horse and rider combination) have to take part in a minim Qualifiers as well as the Final leg to be permitted to compete for the Champi and prize.	
	Novice to Elementary: The score from each test will be averaged out for the Qualifiers. The best two averaged scores from the Qualifiers (Q1, Q2, Q3 & Q4) will count towards the Title of Championship (horse & rider combination per level).
	The Final leg (5 <sup>th</sup> show) will comprise of a Warm-up class followed directly by the Championship / Competition class. The Warm-up class is not mandatory.
	Medium and upwards: The best two scores over the Qualifier legs (horse & rider combination per level) will count.
	Participants riding in Medium, Advance, Small tour, Medium tour and Big tour will only ride a Championship / Competition class at the Final leg (5 <sup>th</sup> show).
	The AVERAGE between the two best Qualifier scores and the Championship / Competition class score will determine the Overall Champion, at that level.
	Anyone can enter the Championship show and compete for the day's winnings. The Championship Title and prizes will however, be based on the participants scores throughout the 2024 Series. A minimum score to win the Championship title and prizes is
