WARM UP ARENA ETIQUETTE

- 1) Pass LEFT shoulder to LEFT shoulder 2)If you are just walking, stay on the inside track
- 2) Be courteous to other riders 3) Stallions must be kept under control at all times

<u>RULES</u>: As per FEI/SAEF/DSA rules, with reference to Para Equestrian-specific rules. This competition is official and all SAEF rules for equestrian events will be enforced. Competitors and horses in all Classes must be registered with SAEF and Dressage SA.

AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS: Horses from outside the AHS Surveillance area must have valid <u>AHS vaccinations (12 months)</u> and a <u>current Certificate of Movement</u>. All horses must arrive at the showgrounds accompanied by a valid Horse Passport. Current Equine flu vaccinations (6 months) - compulsory.

DRESS: As per FEI/SAEF Regulations, with provision for Para Equestrian-specific rules. Approved correct Dressage dress and hats are essential. **TACK**: SAEF regulations regarding spurs and whips will be enforced.

CRUELTY and BEHAVIOUR OF COMPETITORS: The organisers reserve the right to fine, warn, suspend and/or eliminate offenders. Any competitor not available to ride his/her test at the time allotted must contact the TD/JUDGE to arrange for a new riding slot or will be eliminated. The organisers reserve the right to restrict the number of entries accepted to a manageable number. Whilst the programme as scheduled will be adhered to as far as possible, the organisers may at their entire discretion vary such arrangements as are dictated by circumstances.
